







Campground Tour

	<p>Meet us in the lobby at the main entrance at the Crowne Plaza. Buses leave at 8:30 a.m. so grab your coffee early. Please check in with a CIO team member upon arrival. The bus ride is 45 minutes to the campground.</p>

Despite the name, there is no lake but a great swimming pool, arcade, food truck, and store.</p> <p>Since Mark and Mel have taken over running the campground, they have consistently won Camper Choice Awards. Learn how Mark and Mel have partnered with local producers to host an excellent selection of products for their store.</p> <p>We then take a 20-minute drive to Happy Hills.</p>

This multi Camper Choice Award-winning campground features an array of amenities not to be missed. They have swimming pools (indoor and outdoor), a splash pad, driving range, mini putt, petting zoo, 9-hole golf course, RC Car track, playgrounds, jumping pillows, and gaga ball pit, to name a few of this amenity-rich campground.</p> <p>Back on the bus for a 36-minute drive to our next stop, which includes lunch.</p>

	<p>Lunch</p> <p>Lunch will take place in the brand new recreation hall located at Country Gardens RV Park. Details on the menu to come.</p>
	<p>Country Gardens RV Park has recently upgraded their main buildings. A new office, recreation hall, washrooms and patio are just some of the upgrades undertaken. This 235-site campground features a mix of seasonal and overnight sites. Amenities abound in the park, featuring koi ponds, mini putt, a massive playground structure, and of course, a swimming pool and pond.</p> <p>Join Peter, Laura and Alan as they walk us through this campground. Back on the bus to Landings Campground, which is a short 3-minute drive.</p>
	<p>Landings Campground is the last stop of the day. This 122-site campground features a mix of overnight and seasonal camping. It features a pool and a pond full of water toys.</p> <p>Peter will be walking the group through the new septic system design.</p> <p>After a quick 17-minute drive, you will be dropped off at the hotel.</p> <p>Sunday Funday begins at 8:00 pm in the lower level of the hotel.</p>
